September 27, 2011

The flag salute was led by Superintendent Tim Baird.	FLAG SALUTE
The meeting began with introductions of members and attendee Bob Nicholson, Real Property Consultant for the Encinitas Union School District.	SALUTE
Dr. Baird reviewed the Bylaws and Guidelines to be followed. The main responsibilities of the Committee were highlighted as follows: 1) Expenditures to be reviewed without bias; 2) Meetings only as scheduled; 3) Annual Report to be prepared for Board; 4) Minutes to be published.	REVIEW OF BYLAWS
Dr. Baird reviewed the Brown Act and the open meeting requirements: 1) Each meeting to have public comments on agenda; 2) All business done in open session; 3) No discussions outside of meeting; 4) Notice of meeting to be published.	REVIEW OF BROWN ACT
Committee members received a copy of Bond Resolution, Committee Bylaws and Ballot Language. The ballot included the project list.	
Dr. Baird shared that the first of 3 bond sales was complete with the first being \$13 million, 2 <sup>nd</sup> to be in 2014 and third in 2019. He further shared that the District was in receipt of the preliminary audit report which was positive and when finalized would be shared with Committee and made public.	STATUS OF BOND SALES
An overview of expenditures and expense commitments to date totaling \$5,000,000,000 was distributed and reviewed by Assistant Superintendent John Britt and Dr. Baird.	
Several questions of expenses by Committee members were addressed by Dr. Baird i.e. 1) Buyout of technology financing expense prior to passage of Bond was authorized and included within ballot language; 2) Expense for analysis/study of solar needs was allowable expense; 3) All expenditures receive board approval; 4) No District salary expense can be covered by bond dollars with exception of salaries specific to bond process.	
It was agreed that the Committee would meet three times a year and the dates for January and June would be set by District: September for review of year-end report; January for review of audit and development of annual report in June.	AGENDA SETTING
